Chains

79.00 Dry wash in bottom of ravine, 100 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, 190 ft. below top of spur, course E.; ascend.

80.06 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of Tps. 15 and 16 S., R. 56 E., with brass cap mkd.

From the standard cor. of Tps. 16 S., Rs. 55½ and 56 E., hereinbefore described.

North on a true line bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over mountainous land ascend steep S. slope.

2.70 Top of ridge, 70 ft. above standard cor., bears E. and W.; descend steep N. slope.

29.10 Dry wash, 30 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, in bottom of canyon, 500 ft. below top of ridge, course NW.; ascend gradual slope.

33.15 Top of spur, 20 ft. above bottom of canyon, projects NW.; descend.

35.00 Bottom of gulch, 20 ft. below top of spur, course NW.; ascend abruptly over S. slope of ridge with many precipitous limestone ledges.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for the ¼ cor. of secs. 31 and 36, with brass cap
