The bearing of this half mile is N.89°52'W., and the dist. is 40.14 chs.

Continue E. on retracement on same line.

Fall 1.11 chs. S. of the old cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, hereinafter described.

Therefore the bearing of this half mile is N.89°51'W., and the dist. is 40.22 chs.

From the old cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, continue E. on retracement.

After searching diligently at regular intervals I am unable to find any evidence of old cors., until at
