

## Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the E. Bdy. of T. 44 N., R. 50 E.

Chs.

- Continue N. on retracement on same line bet. secs. 19 and 24.
- 40.00 After searching diligently I am unable to find any trace of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.
- 80.44 Fall 110 lks. W. of the <sup>old</sup> cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, hereinafter described.
- Therefore the bearing of this mile is S.0°13'W., and by proportionate measurement the length of each half mile is 40.22 chs.

## Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the E. Bdy. of T. 44 N., R. 50 E.

The old cor. of Tps. 43 and 44 N., Rs. 50 and 51 E., which is a slightly decayed wooden post, 3 ins. square, 18 ins. above ground, and marked faintly with notches on its edges and on its faces with township<sup>S</sup>, ranges and secs.; but no evidence of accessories. Reestablish this Tp. cor. at the same point as follows: Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground beside the old stake for cor. of Tps. 43 and 44 N., R. 51 E., with brass cap mkd:

and dig pits, 30X24X12 ins., N. and S. 4 ft., and E. of post 8 ft. dist.

N.0°17'E. on a resurvey bet. secs. 31 and 36 along the E. bdy. of T. 44 N., R. 50 E.

Over gently rolling land, through dense sagebrush.

- 34.24 Northing of 40.00 chs. from the cor. of Tps. 43 and 44 N., R. 50 E., set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. for sec. 36, only, with brass cap mkd:
