60.50 Bottom of swale, 20 ft. below top of ascent, course NW.;
asc. gradually.

80.51 The cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, 50 ft. above bottom
of swale.

Land; mountainous, strewn with boulders, W. 28.71 chs.;
rough and abrupt, E. 11.80 chs. of W. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile; rolling,
E. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile.

Soil; brown, sandy clay about 6 ins. to 24 ins. deep, lying
on a light clay hardpan or on bed rock, W. 28.71 chs.
and E. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile; surface rock exposed in the form of
broken ledges, boulders, rock slides and rim rock in
rough mountainous portion.

Undergrowth; dense sagebrush.

No timber. Good grazing.

General drainage W. to the Owyhee River, thence N.

Formation; malpais.

Western exposure.

0.29 Midway bet. the cor. of secs. 19 and 30 and the cor. of
