

3 Directions for finding the public land survey monument:

Located about 20 miles northeast of Shoshone, California, in Pahrump Valley, about mid-way between the Pahrump Valley Ranch and the Manse Ranch.

From Shoshone or Las Vegas, go to the Pahrump Valley Ranch, then follow main traveled road southeast toward the Manse Ranch for 1 mile to artesian well, then follow old wagon road southward for 2.6 miles, where 60 feet west of road is a quarter sec. corner stake and a pile of tins and rubbish; from here go straight east cross country (heading for the north edge of the trees at the Manse Ranch) for $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the corner.

Description of reference (or auxiliary) public land survey monuments:

- No. 1 U.S.G.L.O. brass disk marked REFERENCE 1926 and arrow pointing toward the corner. Set in a concrete post, 30 ins. long, 15 ins. diam. at base, 11 ins. diam. at top, 27 ins. in the ground.

Bears: N. 48° 50' 59" E.

Distance: 15.14 meters, 49.67 ft., 0.753 chs.

- No. 2 G.L.O. Corner No. 3-B: The Closing Corner of secs. 1 and 6, Ts. 21 S., Rs. 53 and 54 E.

Original Corner: A mesquite post marked: TXXLS RC1VE SV1 on the east, TXXLS RC111E S1 on the west and CC on the north; in a mound of earth.

New Monument: A brass disk marked:
