

## PRELIMINARY REPORT

Of Public Land Survey Monuments, in the State of Nevada, to which connections were made from the First Order Triangulation Scheme of the U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey in 1926.

G.L.O. No. 1, Clark County, Nevada.

The Standard Corner, secs. 34 & 35, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.M.

## Original Monument:

A mesquite post marked: TXXSXCXIIESXXXIV on the northeast; SXXXIV on the northwest and SC on the south

## New Monument:

Monumented May 3, 1926.

A brass disk marked:

Set in a concrete post, 36 ins. long, 22 ins. diam., at base, 13 ins. diam. at top, 27 ins. in the ground; with the original post alongside.

## Reference Mark:

A brass disk with arrow pointing toward the corner. Set in a concrete post, 30 ins. long, 15 ins. diam. at base, 11 ins. diam. at top, 26 ins. in the ground.

Bears approximately N. 33° E., 12.67 meters.

The corner was connected to U.S.C. & G.S. triangulation stations Black and Charleston.

To reach corner from Las Vegas, Nev. follow road south east toward Searchlight and Needles for 1.7 miles, where the main road turns to the right, take left hand road running straight east for 0.3 mile; take right hand road and follow for 3½ miles to a ranch; turn north between buildings and follow lane for about 1/4 mile to old east and west road, thence east 1/2 mile, where road swings south across dry washes, leave road and drive east about 0.1 mile to the corner, which is just south of being in line with the road running along north side of the ranch.
