Set in concrete post, 36 ins. long, 22 ins. diam. at base, 13 ins. diam. at top, 34 ins. in the ground; with the original stake alongside.

**Reference Mark:**

A brass disk with arrow pointing toward the corner. set in concrete post, 30 ins. long, 15 ins. diam. at base, 11 ins. diam. at top, 27 ins. in ground. Bears approximately N.  $51\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 15.14 meters.

G.L.O. No. 3-B, the C.C. secs. 1 & 6, Ts. 21 S., Rs. 53 & 54 E., bears approximately S.  $87^{\circ}$  E., 82.353 meters.

The corner was connected to U.S.C. & G.S. Stations Pahrump North West Base, Charleston and T 116.

The corner is located about 20 miles northeast of Shoshone, Calif., in Pahrump Valley, about midway between the Pahrump Valley Ranch and the Manse Ranch.

From Shoshone or Las Vegas go to the Pahrump Valley Ranch, then follow main traveled road southeast toward the Manse Ranch for 1 mile to artesian well, then follow old wagon road southward for 2.6 miles where 60 ft. west of road is a quarter section corner stake and a pile of tins and rubbish; from here go straight east across country (heading for the north edge of the trees at the Manse Ranch) for  $1\frac{1}{2}$  mile to the corner.

Closing Corner, secs. 1 & 6, Ts. 21 S., Rs. 53 and 54 E., M.D.M.

**Original Monument:**

A mesquite post marked: TXXIS ROIVE SVI on the east; TXXIS ROIIIIE SI on the west and CC on the north; in a mound of earth.

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
