Heavy growth of sage, deer browse and bunch grass.

Very scattering juniper timber.

N. 0° 01' W. on true line, bet. secs. 20 and 21.

Over rolling land. Asc. S. slope gradually.

10.00 Top of low ridge, 40 ft. above sec. cor., bears N. 85° W. and S. 85° E.; desc. slight N. slope.

30.00 Bottom of descent, 12 ft. below ridge, bears E. and W.; asc. gradual SE. slope 170 ft. to
