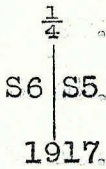
Chains

N. 0° 04' W. on true line bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over broken land.

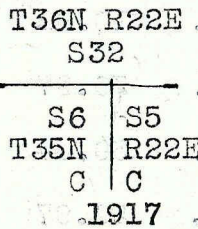
25.80 Draw, course S. 60° W. Asc. S. slope over rimrock.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, lin. dia. 26 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor. This cor. is 80 ft. above draw.

44.51 Intersect the 7th St. Par. N., at a point 2.25 chs., S. 89° 29' W. of the S.C. of secs. 32 and 33, at which point set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with mound of stone around, for C.C. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.

Soil, heavy clay loam, very rocky and shallow, with exposed ledges and rimrock of a volcanic formation.

Good growth of sage, deer browse and bunch grass.
