dig pits, 18 X 18 X 12 ins., in each sec., 5 1/2 ft. dist.

Land is rolling, valley land, draining to the SE.

The soil is a light sandy, clay loam, slightly alkaline, of good depth.

There is a fair growth of greasewood and shadscale.

No timber.

East on true line on the S. bdy. of sec. 36.

Over rolling, valley land.

7.00 Small pond; 5.00 chs. long and 2.00 chs. wide, bears N. and S.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, with brass cap mkd.

Sparse growth of greasewood and shadscale. No timber.
