There is fair growth of greasewood and shadscale.

No timber.

Retracement of the Subdivisions of T. 35 N., R. 24 E.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, heretofore described.

North on retracement bet. secs. 32 and 33.

40.00 Find no evidence of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33. Set temp. point.

80.00 Find no evidence of the old cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33. Set temp. point.

N. 89° 53' W. on retracement, bet. secs. 29 and 32.

40.12 Find no evidence of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. for secs. 29 and 32. Set temp. point.

80.24 Find no evidence of the old cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32. Set temp. point.

S. 89° 42' W. on retracement, bet. secs. 30 and 31.

40.00 Find no evidence of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 30 and 31. Set temp. point.

77.40 From this point, the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, hereinafter described, bears N., 36 lks. dist.

Dependent Resurvey of the Subdivisions of T. 35 N., R. 24 E.

Using the above falling of 36 lks. for a basis of porportion, begin resurvey as follows:

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33.

North on true line bet. secs. 32 and 33.

18.00 E. end of small grove of buckbrush.

40.06 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 26 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
