Undergrowth, sagebrush, bunch grass.

From the cor. of secs. 26 and 35.

S. 1° 03' W. on the W. bdy. of sec. 35.

Over mountainous land descend SE. slope.

11.55 A point by proportionate measurement for the reestablished cor. of secs. 25 and 36.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 25 and 36, with brass cap mkd.
