

Survey of the East bdy. of T.43 N., R.24 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.

Chains.

From the cor. of Tps. 43 and 44 N., Rs. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 25 E., described in book of T.43 N., R.25 E.

Thence, South on East. bdy. of T. bet. secs. 1 and 6.

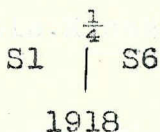
Asc. 170 ft. over rocky N. slope.

9.90 Top of rim rock extending N.60°W. and S.60°E. Asc. 230 ft. over N. slope. Enter mountain mahogany, bears NW. and SE.

31.50 Desc. 100 ft. over rocky S. slope.

36.54 Rim rock bearing E. and W. Continue descent 170 ft. over S. slope. Thence thru scattering mountain mahogany.

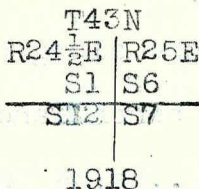
40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock with stone mound around post for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

52.00 Thence over rolling land.

80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap marked



raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, North half mountainous; South half rolling.

Soil, North half bare lava rocks and cliffs; South half shallow sand with bed rock near the surface.

Timber, mountain mahogany.

Undergrowth, sage, some bunch grass.
