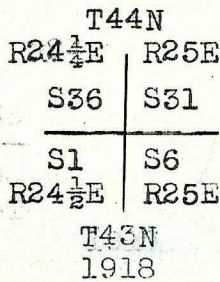


Retracement of Portion of Boundary Camp McGarry Military Reservation

Chains

- .47.70 Top of spur, 40 ft. above head of draw, projects NW.; descend W. and SW. slope.
- 74.00 Bottom of draw, 270 ft. below top of spur, course NW.; ascend 20. ft. to the Tp. cor.
- 78.07 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for the cor. of Tps. 43 and 44 N., Rs. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 25 E., with brass cap mkd.



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, mountainous, drainage northward.

Soil, dark brown clay loam, 10 to 14 ins. deep, rocky and a heavy rocky clay subsoil, some exposed ledges.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, bunch grass.

Timber, scattered growth scrub mountain mahogany.

Retracement of Portion of Boundary Camp McGarry Military Reservation.

From cor. No. 3 of the Camp McGarry Military Reservation, heretofore described, (see field notes of survey of T. 42 N., R. 26 E. for description of cor.) I retrace, S. 17° 47' W. along the W. bdy. of the Camp McGarry Military Reservation.

- 609.87 Intersect a point, 14.60 chs. S. 72° 13' E. of cor. No. 4 of the Reservation, which is a 3 in. iron post, showing 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general. This portion of the boundary bears S. 19° 09' W. and its length is 610.04 chs.
