- 50.00 Ascend rolling NE. slope.
- 54.70 Top of rolling ridge, 20 ft. above $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., bears E. and W.; descend along rolling E. slope.
- 65.40 Road from old Camp McGarry to Surprise Valley, bears N. 70° W. and S. 80° E., branch road to Lemuel Stanleys' ranch, bears N. 80° E.; ascend NE. slope 70 ft. to the sec. cor.
- 80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, with brass cap mkd.

- 79.78 Intersect N. and S. line, 2 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.

Thence,

S. $89^{\circ} 53'$ W. on a true line bet. secs. 29 and 32.

Over rolling land descend.

- 5.00 Ascend rolling slope.

- 5.02 Intersect boundary of Camp McGarry Military Reservation, S. $72^{\circ} 21'$ E., 30.39 chs. dist. from cor. No. 3 of the Reservation, heretofore described. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows:
