Chains

This mile bears S.  $89^{\circ} 47'$  E. and its length is 85.36 chs.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, I retrace East bet. secs. 3 and 34.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. No traces of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. found after diligent search.

80.00 Set a temp. point for the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35. No traces of the old sec. cor. found after diligent search.

From the temp. point for the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, I retrace, East bet. secs. 2 and 35.

40.00 Set a temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. No traces of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. found after diligent search.

80.00 Set a temp. point for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36. No traces of the old sec. cor. found after diligent search.

From the temp. point for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, I retrace East bet. secs. 1 and 36.

40.00 Set a temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. No traces of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of secs. 1 and 36 found after diligent search.

89.36 Intersect a point on N. and S. line, 6.72 chs. S. of the old cor. of Tps. 42 and 43 N., Rs. 26 and 27 E., hereinafter described.
