S. 15° W. 36 3

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 36, with brass cap mkd.

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

43.50 Edge of bench and rim rock ledge, 12 ft. high, facing E., bears S. and N. 15° E.; descend into wide draw.

47.90 Small running stream of spring water, course N. 10° W. in bottom of draw, 70 ft. below top of bench, general course N. 30° E.; ascend NW. slope.

50.64 Old road from Denio to Summit Lake, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.

51.60 Small running stream of spring water, course N.; ascend W. slope.

58.36 A point which has a westing of 40.00 chs. from the NE. cor. of Tp. 42 N., R. 26 E. as determined by operations hereafter recorded.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 1, with brass cap mkd.

84.50 Top of steep ascent, 400 ft. above bottom of draw, bears N. and S.; ascend gradually over rounding N. slope of ridge bearing N. and S.

93.18 Intersect N. and S. line at a point 6.72 chs. S. of the old cor. of Tps. 42 and 43 N., Rs. 26 and 27 E., hereinafter described. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows:
