dig pits, 24 X 18 X 12 ins., crosswise on each line, E. and W., 3 ft., and N. of cor., 7 ft. dist.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, wet and mucky on old lake bed with much alkali, sandy light clay loam on remainder of mile.

Undergrowth, saltmarsh grass, greasewood, wild rye grass

and some sagebrush. No vegetation on lake bed.

No timber.

From the standard cor. of Tp. 46 N., Rs. 28 and 29 E., heretofore described.

North on a true line on the E. bdy. of sec. 36.

Over rolling and broken land sloping W.; descend gradual slope.

0.70 Rocky ravine, 50 lks. wide, 8 ft. deep, course W. ; along rolling W. slope.

14.00 Ascend low hill.

16.60 Top of low hill, 40 ft. above bottom of ravine, bears E. and W.; descend.

23.50 Foot of descent, 40 ft. below top of hill; ascend.

27.80 Top of spur, 80 ft. above beginning of ascent, projects W.; descend.

39.65 Dry wash, 12 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, 70 ft. below top of spur, course W.; ascend SW. slope.

42.46 A point which has a northing of 40.00 chs. from the stand-
