Chains

on S. 35.70 chs., balance of mile has a deep dark loam soil more free of rock and suitable for cultivation, Undergrowth, sagebrush, good growth of bunch grass.

No timber.

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From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36 on the E. bdy. of the Tp., which is a 3 in. iron post, showing 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.

West on a random line bet. secs. 25 and 36.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{3}{4}$ sec. cor.

71.05 Intersect W. bdy. of the Tp., 10 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 25 and 36.

Thence, S. $89^{\circ}55'$ E. on a true line bet. secs. 25 and 36.

Over rolling land sloping NW. ascend gradual slope.

24.30 Dry wash, 5 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course N. 20° W.

26.10 Dry wash, 19 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course N. 20° W.

31.05 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

36.00 Dry wash, 8 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course N. 10° W.; asc.

46.10 Top of low spur, 20 ft. above dry wash, projects N.; along rolling N. slope gradually ascend 60 ft. to the

cor.

68.40 Dry wash, 40 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course N. 70° W.

71.05 The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36.

Land, rolling, drainage N.

Soil, light brown clay loam, sandy and mixed with rocks

and boulders washed from foothills.
