GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

The land of the west and south portion of this township is low rolling mountains, and the soil is a rocky loam, of limestone and basalt formation, and is covered with a medium growth of sage brush and grass undergrowth, and a medium growth of cedar and pinon timber. The land of the NE. cor. of township is gently rolling valley, the soil of which is a gravelly loam and alkaline, and is covered with a medium growth of sage brush. The land of this township is chiefly valuable for grazing. A small stream of water in a draw in the SE. cor. of sec. 36, and a spring of clear water in the NE. quarter of sec. 34 is the only water found on this township.

There was no indications of mineral noted on this township. There are no settlers located on this township.
