


Independent Resurvey of the West Boundary of T. 19 N., R. 62 E.

Chains

Over nearly level land.


40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec cor., with brass cap marked



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

78.50 Dry wash, drains N. 10° E.


80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, with brass cap marked



and dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., in each sec. $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. Land, nearly level. Soil. brown clay loam, almost free from stone. No timber. Undergrowth, sagebrush. Good grazing.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12. North, on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 6. Over nearly level land.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



and dig pits 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of cor., 3 ft. dist.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Ts. 19 and 20 N., Rs. 61 and 62 E., with brass cap marked
