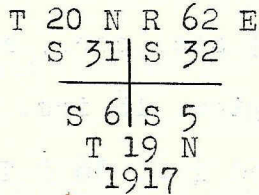


Independent Resurvey of the North Boundary of T. 19 N., R. 62 E.

Chains

77.80 Road, bears N. 15° E. and S. 15° W.

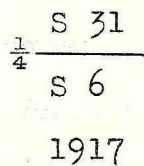
80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, with brass cap marked



and dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., in each sec., 5½ ft. dist. Land, gently rolling. Soil, grayish brown loam. No timber. Undergrowth, sagebrush. Fair grazing.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6 31 and 32;
S. 89° 59' W., on a true line bet. secs. 6 and 31.
Over nearly level land with slight slope to NW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 26 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



and dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., E. and W. of cor. 3 ft. dist.

77.80 Intersect cor. of Ts. 19 and 20 N., Rs. 61 and 62 E., heretofore described.

Land, nearly level. Soil, light brown loam. No timber. Undergrowth, sagebrush. Fair grazing.

Subdivision of T. 19 N., R. 62 E.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36, on S. bdy. of Tp.

N. 0° 1' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over rough mountainous land; through heavy mahogany, fir, juniper, and pinon pine timber. Ascend abruptly.

5.60 Top of main ridge of Egan Mts., 130 ft. above cor., bears
