General Description of T. 19 N., R. 62 E.

This township is at an average elevation of about 7000 ft. above sea and contains gently rolling, rolling, hilly and mountainous land. The gently rolling land is in the NE. and NW. parts of the Tp., along the edges of Steptoe and Butte valleys, comprising about 10% in area. The main range of the Egan Mountains crosses the township from north to south, the crest being
