DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE WEST BOUNDARY OF T.18 N.,R.68 E.

Survey commenced October 4, 1917, and executed with a Heitzler light mountain transit No. 52, with an improved Smith Solar attachment. For full description, approval and test of instrument see the notes of the survey of T. 19 N., R. 61 E., and for final test of the instrument at completion of assignment, see the notes of the survey of T. 24 N., R. 70 E.

I commence at the cor. of Ts. 17 and 18 N., Rs. 67 and 68 E., which is a cedar stake, 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 ins. square, 2 ft. above the ground, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general. I re-establish this cor. as follows:-
