A mahogany, 8 ins. dia., brs. S.76¼°W., 184 lks.

dist., marked T 17 N R 68 E S 2 B T.

A mahogany, 8 ins. dia., brs. N.72¼°W., 41 lks.


dist., marked T 18 N R 68 E S 35 B T.

Land, rough and mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam.

Undergrowth, medium grass.

Timber, Scattering cedars and pinon on E. 51.00 chs. and dense on remaining portion. Scattering scrub mahogany on mile.



East, bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Ascend along SW. slope, over mountainous land, through dense mahogany and scattering fir, cedar and pinon timber.

15.00 Top of mountains, 70 ft. above sec. cor., brs. N. and S. Descend gradually along S. slope.

40.00 60 ft. below top of mountains, on low spur projecting S. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 24 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked on brass cap
