76.70 Gulch, 400 ft. below spur, course E. Ascend.

80.00 55 ft. above gulch.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., on bed rock, 24 ins. in a mound of stone, for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, marked on brass cap
