

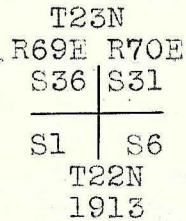
RETRACEMENT OF THE UTAH-NEVADA BOUNDARY.

Chains

Land rolling and low rolling hills. Low hills on S. 40.00 chs. Drainage to the NE.
Soil, deep brown loam mixed with gravel.
Undergrowth, low sage brush.
No timber.

SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T.24 N., R.70 E.

Commence at the cor. of Ts. 22 and 23 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. dia., 12 ins. above the ground, marked on brass cap

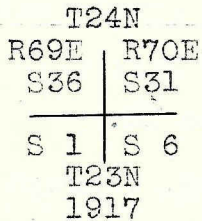


and witnessed by bearing trees.

Thence

North on blank line, through T.23 N., between Rs. 69 and 70 E., and at a distance of

480.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. dia., 24 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of Ts. 23 and 24 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E., marked on brass cap



Dig pits, 24 x 24 x 12 ins., on each line, N., E., and W., 4 ft., and S. of post, 8 ft. dist.

Ibapah peak, on east side of Deep Creek, brs. S.62°42'E.

Mitten rock on west side of Antelope Valley, brs. S.78°W.

From the cor. of Ts. 23 and 24 N., Rs. 69 and 70E., thence East, bet. secs. 6 and 31, along S. bdy. of Tp.

Over nearly level land, through undergrowth of sage brush.

25.20 Wash, 2 ft. deep, 5 lks. wide, course N.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 24 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., marked on brass cap
