


Survey of the West boundary of T. 25 N., R. 70 E.

Chains

- 67.45 Deep drain, course E., desc. N. slope over numerous drains, and draws, courses E. and NE.
- 79.00 Large drain, course E/ asc. SE. slope
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap marked,



1918 ; raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, rolling hills.

Soil, 4th rate, rocky.


Timber, none.

Undergrowth, low sage brush and greasewood.

North, on the West boundary of sec. 6

Over rolling hills, drainage NE.

- .65 Small Spur, falls NE., desc. NW. slope 30 ft. to,
- 10.65 Large drain, course NE.
- 15.20 Enter scattered juniper.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in ground, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked,



1918 ; raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

41.40 Intersect the Fifth Standard Parallel North, at a point, N. 89° 23' W., 13.86 chs., dist. from the Standard ¼ sec.

cor. on the South boundary of sec. 31, T. 26 N., R. 70 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in ground, for Standard closing corner, of T. 25 N., Rs. 69 and 70 East, with brass cap marked,
