- 80.08 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.
- Land; gently rolling, sloping to the W., E. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile; about level, W. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile.
- Soil; deep clay, rich with potash, on lake bed; deep dark loam in places in meadow; light sandy soil, gravelly on surface, about 2 to 3 ft. deep to bed rock, E. 12 chs.; light sandy loam, containing potash, several ft. deep, W. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile.
- Undergrowth; grease wood, shadscale, sagebrush and rabbit brush.
- No timber. Rye grass, salt grass, and wire grass in pasture. Outcroppings of limestone, E. 12 chs.

N.89°44'W. on a random line bet. secs. 6 and 7.

- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 67.46 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp., at the cor. of secs. 6 and 7, heretofore described.
- S.89°44'E. on a true line bet. secs. 6 and 7.
- Over level, dry and barren lake bed.
- 27.46 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked:

and dig pits, 18X18X12 ins., E. and W. of post, 3 ft. dist.

- 67.46 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.
- Land; level and barren lake bed.
- Soil; deep clay, rich with potash.

N.0°02'W. on a random line bet. secs. 5 and 6.

- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 81.27 Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp., 34 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, which is an iron post, 3 ins.
