56.30 Leave cultivated field; enter dense undergrowth, bears NW. and SE.

79.50 Road, bears N. and S.

80.02 Intersect the W. Bdy. of the Tp., at a point 18 lks. S. 0° 02' E. of the reestablished cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, at the point of intersection.  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 6 and 7, with brass cap mkd.
