raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, rolling and mountainous.

Soil, mostly clay with trap rock imbedded and lying on the surface.

No timber.

Undergrowth, shadscale.

North, on the East bdy. of Tp., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Asc. 90 ft. over Steep, rocky, S. slope.

8.50 Spur, slopes E. Desc. 60 ft. over N. slope.

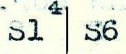
15.00 Gulch, course NE.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked



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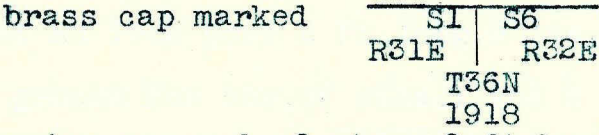
