Thence N.0°01'E.,bet.secs.31 and 32.

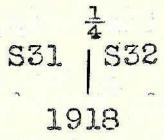

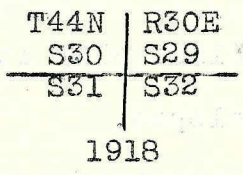
