

Chains To reestablish the cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26, I proceed as follows: As above stated, using a simple proportion for the six miles of meridional retracement, said cor. will be 2X80,974 chs. or 161,95 chs. northerly from the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of Tp., and the departure of same cor. will be determined by using a meander proportion between the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of Tp., and the old cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30 on the E. bdy. of Tp., which is a wooden stake 3 ins. square, 15 ins. above ground, bearing traces of scribings, and witnessed by a stone mound, 2 ft. base, 1 ft. high, W. of cor. This stake is recognized by settlers as being the original cor. The line bet. secs. 24 and 25 is thus determined as being S. 88° 28' E., 79.64 chs., and the line bet. secs. 35 and 36 and 25 and 26 bears N. 0° 23' W. I return to the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of Tp., described in Book on T. 44 N., R. 30 E. Thence N. 0° 23' W., on a true line bet. secs. 35 and 36, Desc. 60 ft. over N. slope.

5.00 Gulch, course SE. Asc. 50 ft. over S. slope.

10.00 Thence over rolling E. slope.

26.11 Gulch, course SE. Asc. 40 ft. over S. slope.

40.00 At the regular distance set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. sec. 35, with brass cap marked

dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of cor. 3 ft. dist.

40.49 Proportional distance; set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. sec. 36, with brass cap marked

dig pits, 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. 3 ft. dist.

55.00 Desc. 50 ft. over NE. slope.

58.15 Wash, course SE. Asc. 60 ft. over S. slope.

73.00 Spring bears W., 15 chs. dist. Desc. 50 ft. over N. slope.

79.83 Wash, course SE

80.98 At proportional distance set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, with brass cap marked.
