

SURVEY OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T. 10 S., R. 68 E.

Chains

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rock and sandy clay; 4th rate.
Undergrowth, blackbrush, cacti; bunchgrass.
Timber, scattered pinon pine.

West, on true line bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over mountainous country, through medium dense undergrowth; asc. 265 ft. on steep NE. slope.

- 6.30 Divide ridge, bears NW. and S.; desc. 200 ft. on steep W. slope.
- 14.00 Draw, course N. 20° W.; asc. 70 ft. on E. slope.
- 18.60 Spur, projects N.; desc. 30 ft. on W. slope.
- 22.40 Draw, course N. 10° E.; asc. 220 ft. on NE. slope.
- 34.00 Spur, projects N. 30° W. from S. 30° E.; desc. 140 ft. on steep SW. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

- Limestone, 4x10x10 ins. mkd. with cross (X) deposited at base of post.
- Continue over mountainous country, through medium dense undergrowth; desc. 585 ft. on steep SW. then W. slope.
- 62.30 Canyon, bears N. and S., drains to N., 200 ft. wide; asc. 495 ft. on steep E. slope.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., over a cross (X) mkd. on solid rock, in a mound of stone, for the cor. of lots 7 and 8, sec. 31, with brass cap mkd.
