North, on true line bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over rolling country, through medium dense undergrowth; desc. 50 ft. to ¼ sec. cor.

5.60 Wash, course E.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
