Chains

Undergrowth, blackbrush, creosote, cacti, and bunch grass.
No timber.

SURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 10 S., R. 69 E.

Feb. 28, 1934: At the cor. of Tps. 10 and 11 S., Rs. 69 and 70 E. heretofore described, a meridian determination is made as recorded on page 2 this book to verify the alinement of the surveyed lines. This meridian, agreeing closely with the azimuth of the surveyed lines, is used to determine the bearing of the line to the north.

North, on true line bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over rolling country, through medium dense undergrowth; asc. 175 ft. on SE. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 6 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

67.80 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.; asc. 10 ft.

76.10 Draw, course SE.; asc. 40 ft. on SW. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, with brass cap mkd.
