49.20 Wash, course N.; asc. 60 ft.

53.55 Ridge, bears N. 10° W. and S. 10° E.; desc. 91 ft.

61.40 Wash, course N. 05° W.; desc. 30 ft.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of lots 7 and 8 sec. 7, and lots 1 and 2 sec. 18, with brass cap mkd.

97.55 Intersect the E. bdy. of T10S., R67E., N. 0° 01' W., 16.87 chs. dist. from the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, R67E., which is a 3 in. iron post mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, this cor. remarked to refer to T10S., R67E., only.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone to top, for the closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, T10S., R68E., with brass cap mkd.
