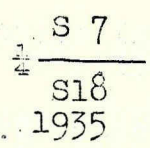


Subdivision of T. 44 N., R. 58 E.

Chains

- 36.70 Low spur, projects NW.; continue descent along a NW: slope; desc. 230 ft. to the 46.30 ch. pt.
- 39.00 Head of draw, drains NW.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

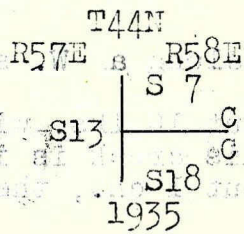


Deposit an igneous rock, 5x6x7 ins., mkd with a cross (X), at base of post.

- 46.30 Stream, about 3 lks. wide and 3 ins. deep, course S. 60° W. This stream is in the bottom of a draw draining S. 60° W. A trail runs along the W. edge of the stream; asc. 115 ft. along a SE. slope.
- 49.50 Low spur, projects SW.; desc. a slight S. slope.
- 53.40 Head of draw, drains SW.; asc. slight SE. slope.
- 56.70 Low spur, projects SW.; desc. 110 ft. along a S. slope.
- 66.80 Trail, bears NE. and S.; asc. 140 ft. along SE. slope.
- 67.80 Draw, drains S. 10° E.
- 74.00 Low spur, projects SE.; continue ascent along SE; slope.
- 78.98 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp.

At the point of intersection,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap mkd.



from which;

- An aspen, 4 ins. diam., bears N. 34°30' E., 15 lks. dist., mkd. BT. only.
- An aspen, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 63° E., 4 lks. dist., mkd. BT. only.

From this point the cor. of secs. 12 and 13, T. 44 N., R. 57 E. bears N. 0°16' W., 48 lks. dist.

Land, rolling hills.
 Soil, rocky and shallow; 4th rate.
 Undergrowth, sagebrush. Native grasses and shrubs.
 Timber, aspen, mahogany and cottonwood.
 Grazing, poor.
