

Subdivision of T. 44 N., R. 58 E.

Chains

From this point the cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T. 44 N., R. 57 E., bears N. 0°13' W., 1.42 chs. dist.

Land, rolling mountains.  
Soil, shallow loam; 3rd and 4th rates.  
Undergrowth, sagebrush, native grasses and shrubs.  
Timber, aspen along stream bank.  
Grazing, good.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.

N. 0°03' W., on true line bet. secs. 5 and 6.


Over rolling mountains, through medium dense undergrowth; asc. 90 ft. along W. slope of spur projecting S.

9.80 End of ascent, bears E. and W.; desc. 100 ft. along a W. slope.

From this point, flag at Mud Springs bears N. 36°15' W., 49.38 chs. dist.

15.50 Drift fence, 3 strand barbed wire, bears E., about 5 chs. dist. to top of spur, and W. about 15 chs. dist. to bottom of draw; continue over rolling hills.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone to top of post, for the 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



63.10 Draw, drains W.; asc. 100 ft. along a W. slope.

74.20 Divide ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 30 ft. over a N. slope.

82.09 Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp.

At the point of intersection,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone to top of post, for the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.

An aspen, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 76°20' E., 64 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. T44NR58ES5CCBT.

This cor. is situated at the head of a broad draw draining E.

From this point the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 45 N., R. 58 E., bears East, 5.62 chs. dist.
