Chains	An aspen, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 44° W., 34 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S36 BT. A balsam, 12 ins. diam., bears N. $37\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 26 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S36 BT. Desc. 45 ft. on a N. slope.
41.35	Draw, course N. 60° E. from S. 70° W.; asc. 75 ft. on a rocky and broken SE. slope.
51.10	Spur, projects E. about 20 chs.; asc. 45 ft.
53.70	Outcrop, 60 ft. high, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.; desc. 215 ft. on a steep N. slope.
57.50	Stream, 3 lks. wide and 3 ins. deep, course N. 60° E. about 10 chs. then SE., from the W.; asc. 145 ft. on a steep and rocky SE. slope.
63.30	Outcrop, 35 ft. high, faces SE. and bears NE. and SW.; on the point of a spur projecting from the NW.; desc. 15 ft.
68.00	Draw, course S. 70° E. from head about 6 chs. N. 70° W.; asc. 195 ft. on a SE. slope.
75.00	Spur, projects S. 30° E. from N. 80° W.; desc. 35 ft. on a N. slope.
80.00	Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for the cor. of secs. 25 and 36 only, with brass cap mkd.

Bunch grass. Timber, aspen, mahogany, balsam, and limber pine. Grazing, fair.

1.60	Draw, course E. from head about 8 chs. W.; asc. 525 ft. on a SE. slope through more scattering mahogany timber.
33.40	Spur ridge, bears S. 70° E. and N. 80° W.; desc. 50 ft. on a NE. slope through a clump of dense mahogany.
40.00	Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
