Chains

A limber pine 14 ins. diam., bears N. 43° E., 25 lks. dist., mkd. T45N R60E S6 CC BT.  
A balsam 16 ins. diam., bears S. 26 1/4° E., 84 lks. dist., mkd. T45N R60E S7 CC BT.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, shallow sandy loam surface, 3 rd. rate.  
Undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush, grouse brush, and manzanita. Bunch grass.  
Timber, aspen, mahogany, balsam, and limber pine.  
Grazing, fair.

N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over mountainous country through heavy mahogany growth; asc. 280 ft. on a SW. slope.

15.80 Spur, from N. 60° W. projects E. and S. 30° E.; desc. 145 ft. on a NE. slope; leave mahogany bearing N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.

28.00 Enter heavy growth of timber bearing E. and W.; desc. 155 ft. to 1/4 cor. on a NE. slope; at 32.00 ch. pt. leave timber bearing E. and W.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

47.50 Stream 1 lk. wide, 1 in. deep, in draw, course N. 60° E.; Spring 50 lks. W.

48.40 Stream 2 lks. wide, 2 ins. deep, course S. 60° E.; asc. 115 ft. on a SE. slope.

54.07 Intersect the Ninth Standard Parallel North.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.
