raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.

51.30 Draw, course NE. from the S.; asc. 55 ft.

64.60 Road, bears N. 15° E. and S.; asc. 5 ft.

75.00 Edge of top, bears N. 30° E. and S. 20° W.; desc. 150 ft. on a NW. slope.

81.92 The cor. of Tps. 46 and 47 N., Rs. 59 and 60 E. which is an iron post 3 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

31.90 Slope changes to a SE. slope; asc. 30 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
