raise a mound
of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

From this point the cor. of Tps. 46 and 47 N., Rs. 58 and 59 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described in the official record, bears S. $89^{\circ}56'$ W., 5.58 chs. dist. As this corner will hereafter refer to T. 47 N., Rs. 58 and 59 E., only, I remove all marks referring to townships to the south, and raise the mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, pine, fir, aspen and mahogany; undergrowth, 2nd growth aspen, sagebrush and willows.

Grazing, good.

SUBDIVISION OF T. 46 N., R. 59 E.

From the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of Tp., hereinbefore described,

N. $0^{\circ}01'$ W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over mountainous country; desc. 30 ft. on a NE. slope, along the base of a ledge bearing N. and S. and through a heavy growth of balsam and pine timber.

- 2.80 Leave base of ledge, bears S. and N. 30° W.; desc. 130 ft. on a steep NE. slope.
- 7.70 Head of draw, course N. 70° E.; asc. 20 ft. on a SE. slope.
- 11.30 Spur, slopes N. 60° E. from SW.; desc. 190 ft. on a steep N. slope.
- 17.00 Leave timber, bears S. 20° E. and NW. about 1 ch., then N.; desc. 420 ft. on a steep N. slope.
- 25.00 Re-enter timber, bears E. and W.; desc. 140 ft. on a N. slope.
- 30.70 Stream, 3 lks. wide and 4 ins. deep in a large canyon, course NW. from SE.; leave balsam and pine timber, bears same as canyon; asc. 130 ft. on a SW. slope through medium dense growth of mahogany timber.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 17 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A mahogany, 3 ins. diam., bears N. $41\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 21 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S36 BT.

A mahogany, 4 ins. diam., bears N. $54\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 10 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S35 BT.

Asc. 110 ft. on a SE. slope through more scattering mahogany.
