Chains

- 45.00 Leave timber, bears E. and W.; desc. 30 ft. on a N. slope.
- 54.00 A strip of dense mahogany timber 2 chs. wide, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 40 ft. on a N. slope.
- 58.00 Low broad spur, slopes N. 15°W. from S. 20°W.; desc. 40 ft. on a NE. slope.
- 61.60 Enter heavy aspen timber bearing NW. and SE.; desc. 90 ft. on a NE. slope.
- 68.40 Leave timber, bears N. 20°W. and SE.; desc. 50 ft. on a NE. slope along the W. side of a clump of mahogany timber.
- 75.70 A spring bears S. 20°W. about 8 chs.; desc. 50 ft. on a NE. slope.
- 79.92 Intersect the S. bdy. of T. 47 N., R. 59 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, with brass cap mkd.

A mahogany, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 21½°E., 57 lks. dist., mkd. T46N R59E S3 CC BT.

An aspen, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 65½°W., 36 lks. dist., mkd. T46N R59E S4 CC BT.

Cor. set in a dense growth of willow and aspen.

From this point the corner of secs. 33 and 34, T. 47 N., R. 59 E., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record, bears S. 89°56'W., 5.18 chs. dist. I alter the markings on this corner by adding S4 T46NR59E to the south half of brass cap.

Land, benchland and steep slopes.

Soil, shallow sandy loam surface, 3rd rate.

Timber, aspen, mahogany, balsam and limber pine; undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush, manzanita, serviceberry, chokecherry, willow and bunch grass.

Grazing, fair.

From the standard cor. of secs. 32 and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., hereinbefore described.

N. 0°03'W., bet. secs. 32 and 33.

Asc. 70 ft. over mountainous land on a SW. slope, through dense pine, fir, aspen and mahogany timber, and an undergrowth of snowbrush, buckbrush, chokecherry and 2nd growth timber.
