
North bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over mountainous land, through dense sagebrush, scattering cedar and pinon pine; desc. gradual N. slope 300 ft.

29.60 Foot of mountain, bears NE, and SW., thence over rolling land.

37.30 Road bears S.80°E. to Pioche and N.80°W. to Kixmiller Ranch.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of sec. 1, only, with brass cap mkd:



40.27 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of sec. 6, only, with brass cap mkd:

A cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears N.36°45'E., 39 lks.

dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 6 B T.

A cedar, 4 ins. diam., bears S.71°45'E., 92 lks.

dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 6 B T.

These  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cors. are located on nearly level land, 35 ft. below foot of mountain.

62.00 Dry wash, 15 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, course NE.
