

Subdivision of T. 5 N., R. 65 E.

Chains.

A cedar, 4 ins. diam., bears S.40°15'W., 97
lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 B T. ✓

Continue gradual ascent over rolling land from $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

55.00 Leave rolling land, 50 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., asc. SW.
slope.

59.90 Enter a medium growth of timber, bears E. and W.

65.00 Rocky spur, 95 ft. above base of ascent, projects SE.;
desc. gradually 5 ft. to

66.00 Intersect the first St. Par. N., 5.66 chs. E. of the
standard $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 35, hereinbefore described, and
at the point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft.
long, 2 ins. dia., 14 ins. in the ground to solid rock
and in a mound of stone for closing cor. of secs. 1 and
2, with brass cap mkd:

A pinon pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S.51°45'E., 27
lks. dist., marked C C T 5 N R 65 E S 1 B T. ✓

A pinon pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S.38°45'W., 34
lks. dist., marked C C T 5 N R 65 E S 2 B T. ✓

Land; rolling, S. 55.00 chs.; rolling and rough mountain-
ous, rocky with boulders and outcroppings of trachyte
and granite, N, 11.00 chs.

Soil; rocky sand, shallow and lying on a brown, gummy
clay a few ins. deep to bed-rock, in the mountainous
portion; dark sandy loam about 10 ins. deep to a clay
subsoil on the rolling land; deeper dark sandy loam in
hollows and along washes.

Timber; cedar and pinon pine.

Undergrowth; dense sagebrush on rolling land, scattering
in the mountainous portion.

General drainage E. Very little grass.

Northern exposure, S. 23.00 chs.; remainder of mile ex-
posed to the S.
