

## Dependent Resurvey of Utah-Nevada State Line.

## Chains.

Soil; about 1 to 3 ft. of rocky, dark sand, lying on a brown clay 6 ins. to 1 ft. deep to bed-rock.

Timber; cedar, pinon pine and mahogany.

Undergrowth; dense sagebrush, young mahogany, deer browse and patches of service-berry bushes.

General eastern exposure and drainage. Fair grazing.

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N.0°08'W. on a dependent resurvey line on the 232nd. mile.

Asc. S. slope, through dense sagebrush, scattering cedar, pinon pine and mahogany.

6.30 Enter heavy mahogany, bears NE. and SW., and leave scattering cedar and pinon pine.

9.05 Point of intersection of the N. bdy. of T. 1 N., R. 71

E., hereinafter established, with the Utah-Nevada State Line.

19.20 Spur, 355 ft. above the 232nd. mile cor., projects S.60°E.; desc.

19.40 Leave heavy mahogany, bears N.60°W. and S.60°E., and enter scattering cedar, pinon pine and mahogany.

22.03 The closing cor. of secs. 26 and 35, T. 32 S., R. 20 W., Utah, bears W. of line 0.04 chs. dist.

22.40 Head of ravine, 40 ft. below spur, course S.60°E.; asc.

35.60 Spur, 230 ft. above head of ravine, projects S.60°E.; desc.

43.00 Enter heavy aspen, bears NW. and SE., and leave cedar, pinon pine and mahogany.

47.70 Leave aspen, bears NW. and SE., and enter scattering cedar, pinon pine and mahogany.

66.70 Head of draw, 620 ft. below spur, course N.60°E.; asc.

74.00 Spur, 20 ft. above head of draw, projects NE.; desc.

83.80 Water pipe line to State Line, Utah, bears E. and W.

89.30 Old road bears N.80°E. and S.80°W.

90.70 Small stream of water in bottom of ravine, 355 ft. below spur, course N.60°E.; asc. SE. slope 15 ft. to

91.59 The 231st. mile cor. which is a partly decayed pinon
