General Description.

This fractional township is located in a range of mountains lying between Utah and Nevada, and is bounded on the east by the State of Utah. The land varies from rolling mountainous to steep and rough mountainous with many canyons draining the township southwesterly to the Meadow Valley Wash, except some tracts in the south and extreme eastern parts which drain east and southeasterly into Utah. Deer Lodge, Service-berry, Dursey and Water Canyon are the principal canyons in this portion of the range, each having a small stream of water flowing the year round, but becoming very small late in the summer. A basin known as Ox Valley, which embraces nearly all of the west half of section five and about all ^{of} the east half of section six, has several small springs, some of which dry up late in the season.
