Chains

From the true point for cor. of secs. 1 and 2 , on N. boundary.

S.0°01'E., between secs. 1 and 2.

Asc. 1235 ft. over very rough and broken N. slope, thru very scattering timber.

29.60 Top of abrupt asc. Asc. over gradual N. slope.

40.00 Set iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 12 ins. in the ground, supported by mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, for the ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

40.00 Set temp. for ¼ sec. cor.

80.24 Intersect E. boundary, 18 lks. N. of the cor. Of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, which is a iron post, described in the field notes of T. 9 N., R. 29 E. of this group. N. 89°52'W., on true line, between secs. 1 and 12. Asc. 717 ft. over steep NE. slope, over open land.
