Desc. 1423 ft. over NE. slope, covered with scattering sage brush.

40.00 Set iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 12 ins. in the ground, supported by mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 20 ins. high, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

50.49 Head of the N. fork of Dutch creek, dry, course E. Asc. 391 ft. over SE. slope.

55.50 Enter timber, bears E. and W.

69.60 Top of ridge, bears E. and W. Leave timber, bears SE. and NW. Desc. 232 ft. over N. slope.

80.00 Set iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 14 ins. in the ground, supported by mound of stone, 3 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36,
